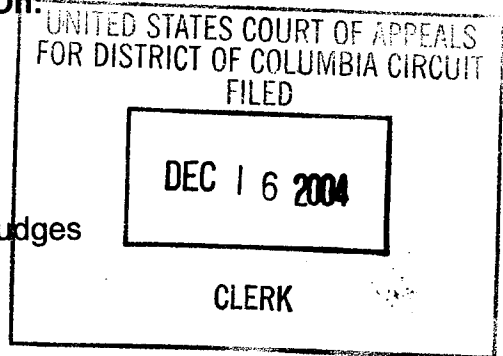

## ORDER
